

Great Beighton Bake Off

Rules of entry

1. If you are entering a 'decorated cake' - the decoration theme for the cakes is 'Harvest'. The cakes will be judged on decoration alone as we will be auctioning them at the end of judging. You can therefore make whatever flavour cake you like as a base for the decoration (lemon drizzle, chocolate cake etc..).
2. If you are entering a cake without decoration, these will be sliced for tasting, and will be sold by slice once judging has taken place.
3. Please specify on the entry form which category you would like to enter.
4. All cakes will be numbered, and so judged anonymously by those attending. The organisers will give your cake a number upon entry to the competition.
5. Cakes entered into the competition will be judged by those attending the event and small prizes will be given for the three cakes which receive the most votes, in descending order, for both taste and decoration categories.
6. Any proceeds from the evening will be donated to St Mary's Church funds and the Cathedral Archer Project, as we support that project during the Harvest season.
7. A full ingredients list must accompany each cake, to ensure that those buying the cakes are fully aware of any potential allergens.
8. All ages can enter the competition (parents - just let us know if the entrant is under 18 please)
